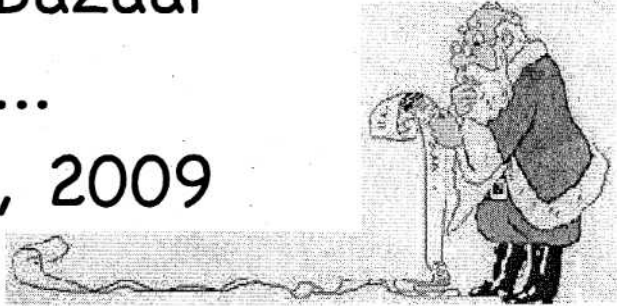


The Jingle Bell Bazaar is coming ... December 10th, 2009



The Jingle Bell Bazaar is our annual Christmas bazaar held during the school day in the gym. Students browse through donated items and buy gifts for their immediate families. Our younger students particularly enjoy this, as they get to surprise family members with gifts that they pick out all on their own. Items are priced between \$0.25 and \$2 and are wrapped for your child.

To add to the festivities, there is the ever popular **bake sale**. We have a **raffle** and **popcorn**, as well as a potluck **luncheon** held by the volunteers for the volunteers and staff. And then, of course, **Santa** comes for a visit.

To make this event run smoothly, we need your help in many ways. Please read through the requests and help where you can.

1. **Donations for the Bazaar** – send in gently used or new items. There is a donation box in each classroom as well as at the office. We request that you send in at least one item for each gift that each of your children will be purchasing. For example, if you have two children at MPS and each child will be purchasing a gift for one mother, one father, one stepmother and two siblings, then 10 items are needed. Popular items include gift cards (Timmies, ...), bath items, jewelry, decorative items, toys, books, games, candles, mugs, tools, work gloves, car scrapers, golf, fishing and other sports items. We are always short of gifts for dad, so ask dad what he might like and consider these items for donation. No clothes, please.
2. **Sorting and wrapping time** – during the time between now and the date of the bazaar we sort, clean and package the items received as needed. The time(s) and date(s) for this will be announced.
3. **Donations of wrapping supplies** – each gift purchased by a child is wrapped by our volunteers. We need wrapping paper, gift bags, gift tags, ribbon, tape, cellophane and whatever else you think might be useful.
4. **Set up the Bazaar** – this occurs on December 9th right after school and involves setting up the tables in the gym, putting out the gift items and generally making the gym a festive place.
5. **Help run the Bazaar** - this involves helping the children choose and wrap the gifts, selling raffle tickets and baked items and generally enjoying the fun. We need your time between 8am and 3pm on December 10th. If you can't volunteer for the full day, come in for a half day. At the end of the day, we pack up the bazaar.

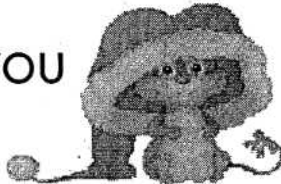
6. **Send in goodies for the Bake Sale** – Send in some of that amazing baking that you do for the holidays. If you don't bake, that's ok – purchased items are welcome.
7. **Volunteer for the Volunteer Lunch** – Our volunteer luncheon is very popular. We feed approximately 60 people including Santa, volunteers and staff. We need people to help set tables, prepare and serve the potluck items and cleanup afterwards from about 11am until 2pm.
8. **Send in a potluck dish for the Volunteer Luncheon** – hot dish or cold, appetizers, main course, salad, dessert – all are welcome.
9. **Donate a Raffle Item** – we sell raffle tickets for items donated by our parents and supporters. If you can donate an item for the raffle, please send it into the school with a note, or contact our volunteer coordinator.
